

8 QUICK FACTS ABOUT PLANNED PARENTHOOD

1. Margaret Sanger founded Planned Parenthood to reduce births among the “unfit.” She publicly advocated for eugenics and spoke at KKK rallies. She founded Planned Parenthood to reduce births among the “unfit.” In 1916, she opened the first birth control clinic in the United States in Brooklyn, New York. This led to her arrest, as birth control was illegal at the time. In 1921, she founded the American Birth Control League, which later merged with other organizations to become Planned Parenthood Federation of America in 1942.
2. Since Roe v. Wade in 1973, over 63 million abortions have taken place in the U.S.
3. Planned Parenthood commits over 400,000 abortions every year—more than 1,100 per day.
4. For every 1 adoption referral, Planned Parenthood commits about 187 abortions.
5. In 2023 Planned Parenthood received nearly \$800 million in taxpayer funding which is a 50% increase since 2013.
6. 96.9% of Planned Parenthood’s “pregnancy services” are abortions.
7. Planned Parenthood performs zero mammograms per year. Despite what many people think, they do not provide this service.
8. The number of annual abortions performed by Planned Parenthood has been in decline since 2012.
